


**BEFORE THE HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE V. K. JADHAV,**  
**CHAIRMAN,**  
**COMMISSION OF INQUIRY**  
**STATE OF GOA**  
**ORDER**  
**(Dated 23.01.2023)**

1. In part compliance with the order dated 18.01.2023, the Presenting Officer has submitted the information pertaining to 27 F.I.R. registered at various Police Stations in the State of Goa, in chronological manner. As directed in the order dated 18.01.2023, the Presenting Officer has submitted 27 folders containing therein F.I.R. / crime information separately. All these 27 folders have been accepted and taken on record.
2. The learned Presenting Officer, however, seeks time of one week to make further compliance of the order dated 18.1.2023. The learned Presenting Officer, on oral telephonic instructions from S.I.T. Chief, submits that on the next date of hearing, there will be a compliance of the order dated 18.01.2023, completely and positively.
3. In view of the above submissions, stand over to 31.01.2023, as a last chance, for the remaining compliance of the order dated 18.01.2023.
4. In the order dated 18.01.2023, this Commission has directed as follows :
  9. In the event, if any interested person seeks to approach the Commission about his redressal of grievance pertaining to the land grabbing, he may furnish, as far as possible, all the details as above and such statement / information shall be supported by an affidavit.



It is hereby made clear that the complaints by interested persons if found vague or anonymous or pseudonymous or illegible or trivial or frivolous and further if they found to be relevant to the civil disputes such as property rights, contractual obligations, the Commission may dismiss in limine the said complaints. The Commission may also dismiss such complaints for any other suitable reasons.

In compliance with the above directions, only one person has approached to this Commission today. However, he has not brought his complaint in the format as directed in the order dated 18.01.2023. He has no knowledge about the directions given in the order dated 18.01.2023. It appears that, so far as, the private complainant / interested persons are concerned, there is no effective compliance of the order dated 18.01.2023, due to lack of information / knowledge. In view of the same, the Collector, North Goa, is hereby requested to give the publicity to the orders passed by the Commission, time to time, through the Department of Information and Publicity, Panaji and further direct the said Department to submit the compliance report directly to this Commission of Inquiry.
