**ORDER**  
**(Dated 15.05.2023)**

Mrs. Tema Narvekar, Special Public Prosecutor and Mrs. Cristina C. Dias are present.

Heard.

1. Mrs. Cristina C. Dias, submits that there are large number of documents received from the various Government Departments under the provision of Right to Information Act, 2005 and in addition to the same certified copies of certain documents are also obtained from the Civil Court.
  
  2. Mrs. Cristina C. Dias, submits that some more time is required to arrange the documents neatly and to prepare the exhaustive list of documents. She further submits that it is also necessary to give a notice to admit documents to the learned Special Public Prosecutor Mrs. Tema Narvekar and also to the accused person/s and others if so required.
  
  3. It appears that Mrs. Cristina C. Dias along with her clients has obtained the documents from various Government Departments under the provision of Right to Information Act, 2005. It is thus necessary to present those documents before the Commission along with the list of documents mentioning

therein the serial number, description of the document, date of document and remarks. In the remarks column it is necessary to mention about the nature of the document/s i.e. as to whether the same is original / certified copy or authenticated Xerox copy. The learned Special Public Prosecutor Mrs. Tema Narvekar, has no objection to grant time for the same, however according to her, she would also require the time to obtain the specific instructions from the concern Department about issuance of those copies to the applicant/s under the provision of Right to Information Act, 2005.

4. On careful perusal of Affidavit of Evidence of Mrs. Cristina C. Dias it appears that in Para 31 (II) certain allegations have been made against Advocate Madhumita Nayak Salatry. In view of the same the said Advocate Madumita Nayak Salatry would likely to be prejudicially affected. It is thus necessary to issue the notice to her under Section 8-B of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952.


5. Thus issue notice to Advocate Madhumita Nayak Salatry under Section 8-B of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952, returnable on or before the next date of hearing. This Commission directs Mrs. Tema Narvekar, Special Public Prosecutor, to arrange to serve the notice on Advocate Madhumita Nayak Salatry through the concern Police Station having local jurisdiction over the area in which the said Advocate Madhumita Nayak Salatry resides. It is needless to say that the said Advocate Madhumita Nayak Salatry has right to cross examine Mrs. Cristina C. Dias, may address the Commission and may be represented before the Commission by any other person with the permission of the Commission. The Commission further directs Mrs. Cristina C. Dias to serve the copy of Affidavit of Evidence on Advocate Madhumita Nayak Salatry in advance. Mrs. Cristina C. Dias undertakes to supply to advocate Madhumita Nayak Salatry the said documents on her appearance before the Commission.
